READING, READING, READING

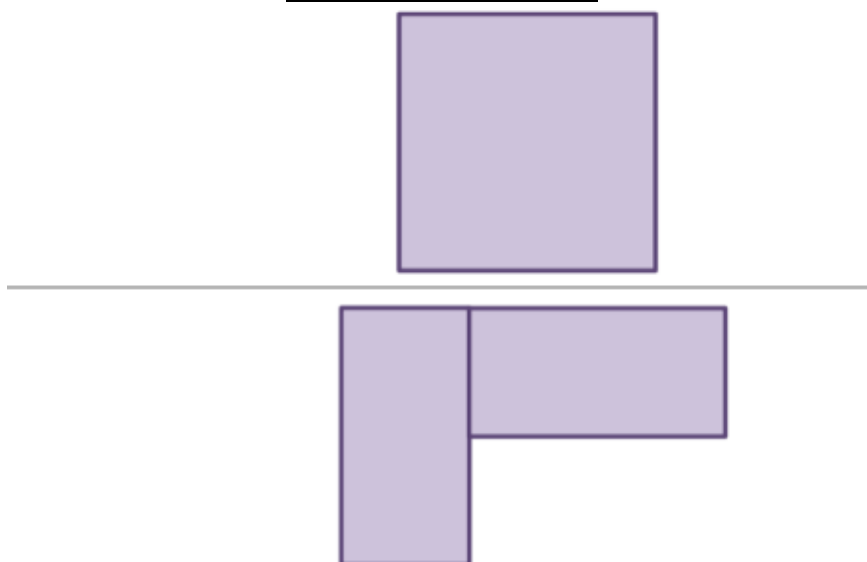
