Happy New Year! We hope you have had a lovely Christmas break and are ready to go into the second term of Year 5. The spring term in Year 5 promises to be very exciting as we have a range of experiences and activities planned including our Shakespeare project. We hope to have an amazing time on our residential trip to Stratford-upon-Avon next week. Later this term, we will be getting ready for our performance of 'Macbeth and organising roles within the next few weeks.

Our topic work this term is history based, continuing our study of the Victorians; science will cover Life Cycles. Literacy this term includes a narrative, Shakespeare and work on scripts. We will continue to do a variety of activities including drama, extended writing, comprehension work, grammar and weekly spelling work.

Numeracy continues daily with topics including place value, problem solving, multiplication and division, fractions and decimals, shape and space, angles and arithmetic. Please join us in encouraging and helping your children to learn and *apply* their times tables (e.g. by knowing "5 x 6 = 30, so 30 ÷ 6 = 5, 30 ÷ 5 = 6 and 32 ÷ 6 = 5r2).

- MFL - Spanish
- PE - Tactical games
- Music - Practising for our Shakespeare performance-songs
- Computing - Video production
