Reading in Year 1

At school, every child will read their selected Little Wandle phonics book three times a week in a reading practise group; they will take this book home at the end of the week. Please read this book with your child every day to further secure their fluency and understanding.

Your child will receive their reading diary and first reading book by Friday 12th September. In it you will find all the information about reading at home. If any parents, or grandparents, are available during the week to come in and listen to children read for an hour or two we would really appreciate it. Please let your class teacher know if you are available.

P.E.



Curriculum
