Literacy, Numeracy and SATs

In Literacy, we are starting this half term with looking into the Titanic! The children are loving diving into a range of non-fiction books on the subject alongside reading the novel 'The Titanic Detective Agency'.

In Numeracy, we are kicking things off with Algebra, before moving onto decimals. The children will then be applying this learning to working with fractions/ decimals / percentages.

As we prepare the children for SATs, we will be extending our numeracy and literacy sessions to include booster lessons later in the term. The tests will take place between **11th - 14th May**. Please put this date in your diary as it is **very important that all children are in school that week!** Do not panic if you have questions about the SATs, as an information meeting for Parents will be held before the tests, where you can find out more about what they entail.
