YEAR 6 SUMMER TERM 2026

Welcome back after the Easter break. We trust you had a happy and relaxing time with your families and that the children are ready for their final term at Haydn; it promises to be very busy and exciting.

Key Stage 2 SATs commence the week beginning Monday 11th May. The children have worked extremely hard all year and we are very proud of them. Please make sure your child is in school **every day** that week; please contact school early if there is a problem on any particular day. We would like to invite the children to arrive at school at 8:30am for breakfast, where there will be a range of pastries and fruit.

After SATs, we will be participating in the **GREAT Project**, starting on the 8th June. This consists of four sessions and enables Primary School children to gain knowledge about healthy relationships. We have been involved with this for the last eight years and the children have thoroughly enjoyed it. In addition, we will be teaching **SRE (Sex and Relationships Education)**. The following topics will be covered over a four-week period: Puberty and Reproduction; Understanding Relationships; Conception and Pregnancy and Communicating in Relationships. You will receive further information before the lessons begin.

Numeracy and Literacy lessons will continue, to ensure our children are well prepared for secondary school. Numeracy sessions will include The £5 Challenge. Other curriculum topics will include: History - Leisure & Entertainment in the 20th Century, Science - Renewable Energy, Geography - Living Things and Exploring Identity in Art. In Computing, the children will be using the programme 'Tinkercad' to design and create a product that will be printed using our 3D printer. We are also looking forward to an exciting Arts Week.

On Wednesday 17th June, we leave for Shropshire via Alderford Lake for an exciting and well-deserved adventure! Could any final payments be made as soon as possible please.

In June and July, the children will be attending induction days at their Secondary Schools and transition staff from some of the schools will be visiting the children at Haydn.

We are now beginning to prepare for our end of year production 'I'm an 11 year old, Get Me Out Of Here. The performances will take place on Tues 14th July and Wed 15th July at 6pm.
