| Literacy | Reading a variety of fiction and non-fiction books linked to our topics. Working on improving sentence structure and spelling the tricky words. Learning how to extend sentences using conjunctions (and, because) and include adjectives to describe objects/characters. |
| Maths | Addition and subtraction within 20, place value (within 20) and measurement. |
| Science | Observing seasonal change specifically linked to winter and spring and investigating different materials and their purposes. |
| History | Significant individuals such as Polar Explorers - Mathew Henson, Felicity Aston and Astronauts - Neil Armstrong and historical events and their causes and consequences. |
| P.S.H.E./R.E. | Talking about our Dreams and Goals and discussing a healthy lifestyle. Caring for others. |
| P.E. | Dance and agility. |
| Computing | Programming and grouping data. |
| DT | Designing and making boats. |
| Art | 3D model making and observational drawings. |

To help your child to continue to make good progress we ask that you try to read at home **every day** for at least 10 minutes, **recording it in your child's reading diary**. It is important that we can monitor how often the children are reading at home and that we can record the children's reading in school. We change the children's books once a week and your child will receive a phonics reading book and a book from the class library.
