F2 SUMMER TERM 2026

Welcome back to our busy summer term! Our term has begun with the topic 'Once upon a time'. We have been reading 'Little Red Riding Hood' and to end the half term we will be immersing ourselves in the story, 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. After May half term, our topic will be 'Out and About'. We will explore seasonal changes in the garden and learn about life cycles as we read 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and will watch our very own class caterpillars change into butterflies. We will be reading Jack and the Beanstalk and to bring our learning to life we have an exciting visit planned to Bestwood Educational Centre where the children will be immersing themselves in the well-loved traditional tale.

During our circle times we will be discussing relationships at school and at home and beginning to think about the transition to year 1. We will send out more information regarding our transition process later in the term.

Underpinning this work are all the new skills we are learning and practising. We are becoming much more confident at applying our phonics skills to independent reading and writing tasks and can't wait for you to see our super writing at the end of the year. We are continuing to develop our fine motor skills to use tools safely and efficiently. Please ensure that your child continues to read with an adult every day at home. If you are able to offer any time as a reading volunteer, it would be very much appreciated.
