May we remind you to **please label all items of school uniform**, particularly cardigans and jumpers as it is tricky at the end of the day when we have lots which have been removed and have strayed from their owner! Also, as the weather is warming up, please make sure your child has a water bottle (containing only water) and a sun hat. Please also send your child to school wearing sun cream on sunny days. Children are welcome to bring labelled sun cream to school to be reapplied. Whilst we are not allowed to help apply this, we will of course supervise application.
