We have had another week full of new learning in school. The children continue to settle well into their new classes and routines have been established. 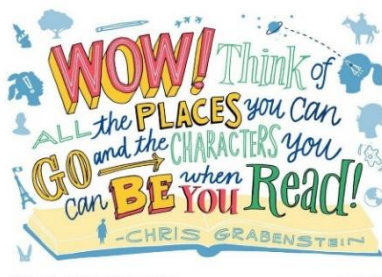
