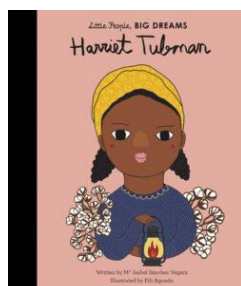

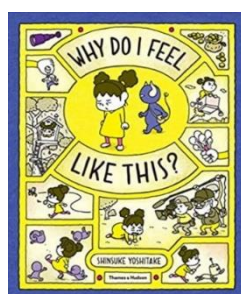
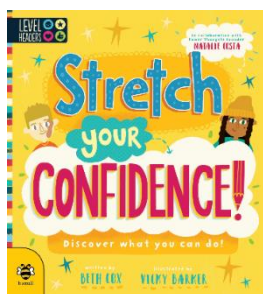
World Mental Health Day
