Donations being asked for at the moment are: wine, empty wine bottles with lids, tombola prizes, raffle prizes, biscuit decorating bits.

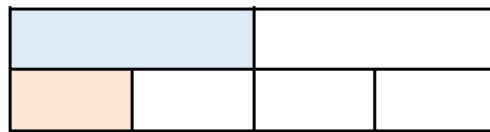

What is the number Mr Patel started with? This bar model may help you.

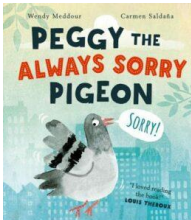

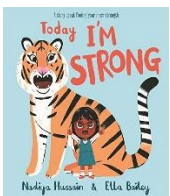
### Anti-Bullying Week

There are many great books to choose that can help children understand what bullying is and how children can learn strategies to overcome it. Below are some examples of lovely books.



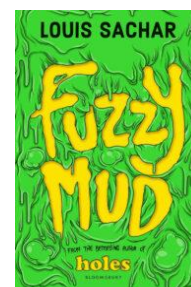
