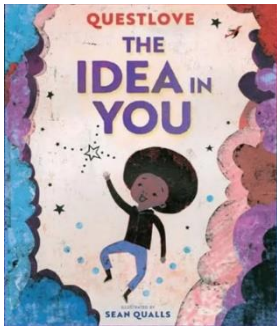

### READING READING READING

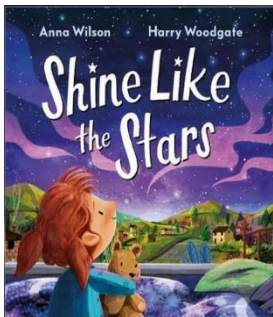
January is a great time to continue or start a good reading habit. Did you know that books expose children to 50% more words than television?

Below are some lovely new titles for 2025.



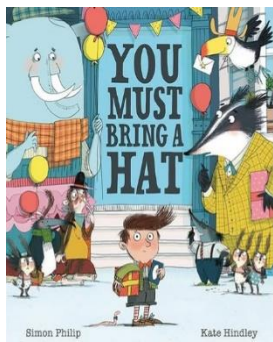
