SCHOOL ROOF REPAIRS

Just a reminder that the repairs to the school roof will begin next Monday, 9th June and, if all goes to plan, will be completed before the children return to school in September.

The main areas that will be affected will be the Key Stage 2 playground and the classrooms of 5H, 5C and 4EG. Each class will move out of their classroom for one week at a time and will be based in the current Year 2/3 intervention room next to the library. The external doors to the three classrooms will not be in use for the duration of the work (except in the event of a fire) but the Key Stage 2 gate and entrance will still be in use and the children will use this at the beginning and end of each day. The football pitches and the field will also still be able to be used.

We thank you in advance for your co-operation and apologise for the disruption that the work will inevitably bring.
