## WARM/HOT WEATHER

## LOST PROPERTY - A MESSAGE FROM ANDREA (PTA)

Lost property ahoy! Did you know that almost our entire lost property collection at Haydn is navy blue jumpers, hoodies and cardigans? And only 1 in 10 items is labelled with a name.

On average, approximately 30 jumpers a month are lost and unclaimed - that's 1 jumper a day, every day, and assuming 10 months in the school year, around 300 jumpers annually that we're working hard to keep out of landfill. Fast fashion is one of the larger sources of carbon emissions in the UK, so let's keep our school jumpers out of that category!

Small pre-loved jumpers will be on offer to visiting families in F2 on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> July. The PTA are holding a fundraising second hand uniform sale at Sherwood Methodist Church on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> July (10am-12pm), and some washed and cared-for pre-loved school jumpers will also make their way there from lost property, amongst their other donations.

Lost property will also be displayed on tables and racks during the last week of term, to make it easier for parents to find their missing items, or re-home some of the older items that are unclaimed.

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## ART, ART, ART!

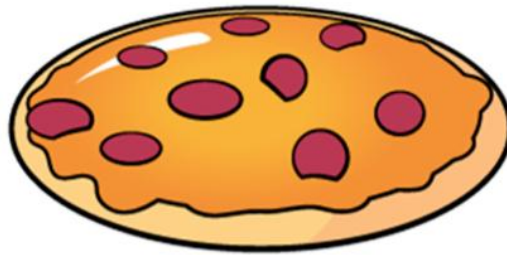
