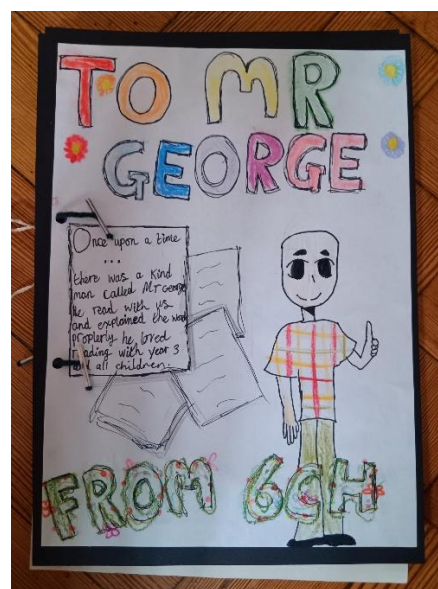
A SPECIAL THANK YOU ASSEMBLY FOR MR GEORGE - READING VOLUNTEER
